Research Analysis

SB 1755 provides that no medical marijuana business license will be issued until all relevant local licenses and permits have been issued by the municipality, including an occupancy permit or certificate of compliance, and all necessary inspections and reviews, including plan reviews, life safety inspections, and compliance inspections, have been completed. If an applicant has not met these requirements but has fulfilled all other required obligations, the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority (OMMA) is to grant a conditional license, which does not entitle the applicant to operate or act as a licensee. Once the applicant has met the requirements of the measure, OMMA may approve the application.
