Research Analysis

SB 176 establishes that following an emergency declaration the accumulation limits for annual leave can temporarily increase and carry over until the end of fiscal year 2023. The measure also provides that any annual leave accrued or expired during the emergency declarations issued in 2020 or 2021 regarding the coronavirus (COVID-19) should carry over until the end of fiscal year 2023 regardless of regulatory provisions. Expired annual leave should be reinstated as of May 7, 2021 for employees that were employed with the State of Oklahoma as of May 7, 2021.
