## **Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for SB 1780 authorizes the Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority to issue obligations to acquire real and personal property of existing Oklahoma Historical Society facilities for the purposes of construction, repair, and rehabilitation in a total amount necessary to generate net proceeds of \$46 million. No proceeds may be expended on the Oklahoma Museum of Popular Culture. Unless at least 50 percent of the proceeds have been obtained within three years of the effective date of the act, the provisions of the measure will cease to have the force or effect of law.
