SB 1784 allows licensed beer distributors and wine and spirits wholesalers to hire employees under the age of 21 as long as the employee is at least 18, is accompanied by a coworker who is at least 21, and enters for the sole purpose of merchandising or delivering product to the licensee.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure, as engrossed, would allow employees of a licensed beer distributor or wine and spirits wholesaler who are at least 18 years old but less than 21 years old to enter a retail spirits store for the sole purpose of merchandising or delivering products, provided that such employees are accompanied by another employee who is at least 21 years old.

Upon review, no direct fiscal impact to the state is anticipated from passage of the measure.
