**Research Analysis**

The amendment to SB 1822 removes the requirement that signage reference the COVID-19 Recovery and Resilience Initiative. It also strikes language that the Legislature's intent is to reference the Oklahoma Joint Committee on Pandemic Relief Funding and the year completed, instead requiring such references. Finally, the amendment deletes language that required the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department to oversee the design and placement of signage. Instead, the project awardee must fund the design and placement with assistance from the Department if necessary.
