Research Analysis

The engrossed version of SB 1828 allows the Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation Commission to create a velvet buck season during the last week of August in the counties where the commission determines the quantity and health of the velvet bucks warrant an open season. The measure authorizes the commission to create rules to conduct the season, create the special license and determine the fee, and prohibits license refunds if the season is cancelled.
