Research Analysis

SB21 requires school boards to adopt policies regarding suicide awareness and training. The measure requires all school district staff to receive evidence-based suicide prevention training on a biennial basis beginning with the 2021-2022 school year.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 21 requires, rather than allows, each school district to adopt policies related to suicide awareness and training and the reporting of student drug abuse beginning with the 2021-22 school year. If a school district chooses not to use the free resources provided by ODMHSAS and instead selects a training program from the list maintained by ODMHSAS, there may be a cost to purchase the training program. Based on the information from ODMHSAS, it would cost approximately \$0.00 to \$6000 per site depending on the chosen curricula and the target population. In addition, school districts may incur cost for training facilitation and preparation.
