SB 241 requires every registered manufacturer and distributor of controlled dangerous substances to provide information monthly regarding the sale of controlled dangerous substances to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control. These reports may be in the same format used when reporting similar information to the federal Drug Enforcement Administration.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The measure provides that manufacturers and distributors of Schedule II-V controlled dangerous substances report certain information monthly to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control.
