Research Analysis

SB 242 modifies the membership of the Council on Law Enforcement and Education Training (CLEET) by requiring the appointee from the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology to have experience in the creation and review of curriculum as well as experience in teaching criminal justice or law enforcement courses. The measure further requires CLEET's application form for any state supported technology center to offer classes not exceed 20 pages.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure modifies the requirements for one seat on the Council of Law Enforcement Education and Training's Curriculum Review Board. The measure also modifies the application process for technology centers and institutions of higher education to offer law enforcement training.

Officials with CLEET estimate that the measure may increase the number of entities applying to offer law enforcement training. An increase in applications and subsequent monitoring of approved entities would require one additional full-time equivalent employee. The estimated cost associated with this employee provided by CLEET is \$100,000, which includes salary, benefits, and vehicle expenses required for travel.
