## **Research Analysis**

SB261 creates the "Oklahoma Student Borrower's Bill of Rights Act". The measure prohibits student loan servicers from:

- Directly or indirectly defrauding or misleading student loan borrowers;
- Engaging in deceptive practices, like misrepresenting the amount of the loan, the nature or terms of fees, or the borrower's obligations;
- Obtaining property by fraud or misrepresentation;
- Incorrectly applying or failing to apply a student's loan payments to the outstanding balance;
- Providing inaccurate information to a credit bureau about a borrower;
- Refusing to communicate with an authorized representative of the student loan borrower; and
- Failing to inform borrowers of their federal income repayment options, and failing to inform borrowers if their loan does not qualify for loan forgiveness programs.
