**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 270 makes changes to the Oklahoma Veterinary Practice Act, including changing the definition of telemedicine or telehealth, allowing for scholarships, and making it easier for military personal or their spouses to be licenses upon transferring to Oklahoma. Officials at the Veterinary Board does not believe this bill will create any fiscal impact for the Board. Additionally, the Board is a nonappropriated agency, therefore there will be no impact to the State.

The Conference Committee Substitute does not change the fiscal analysis.
