## **Research Analysis**

Engrossed SB272 requires a wireless telecommunications carrier, upon request of law enforcement, to provide call location information in order to respond to a call for emergency services, or in an emergency situation that involves risk of death or serious physical harm. The measure requires a wireless carrier and a reseller of wireless services to submit emergency contact information for the carrier to the OSBI to facilitate these requests from law enforcement for call location information.

The measure creates the "Kelsey Smith Act", which relates to call location information provided to law enforcement agencies.
