Research Analysis

Engrossed SB282 allows, during an emergency declaration, a temporary increase in accumulation limits for state employee annual leave, which may carryover to the end of the fiscal year in which the emergency declaration ends.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 282 in its current form allows for the carrying-over of annual leave above leave-cap hourly limits in the event of an emergency declaration. Officials from the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) anticipate no material fiscal impact on state agencies as a result of the provisions of SB 282, because the measure does not require state agencies to pay for such excess annual leave hours, and if such hours are not used during the period of extension they would expire once the annual leave cap is reinstated post emergency.
