Engrossed SB333 allows, in the event of an emergency declaration, accumulation limits for state employee compensatory time to temporarily increase and carry over to the end of the fiscal year in which the emergency declaration ends.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 333 in its current form allows for the carrying-over of annual leave beyond the compensatory time limits in the event of an emergency declaration. Officials from the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) anticipate no material fiscal impact on state agencies as a result of the provisions of SB 333, because the measure does not require state agencies to pay for such excess compensatory time, and if such hours are not used during the period of extension they would expire once the compensatory time limit is reinstated post emergency.
