**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute to SB 338 modifies the requirements for certain positions in the Department of Public Safety. The measure provides that no person can be appointed unless the person is a citizen and of good moral character. The Commissioner is to determine minimum qualifications for all positions. The measure prohibits commissioned officers of the Department from being a candidate for any political office or contribute any money or other thing of value to any political campaign.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The committee substitute to the measure would clarify statutory language regarding qualifications for service in the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. Existing qualifications are kept, but reordered for clarity.
