Research Analysis

Engrossed SB 340 modifies requirements regarding the review of a criminal background check and a child abuse and neglect information system check in a home study to remove the requirement that prospective adoptive parent or other adult household member sign a release of information allowing the release of any search results to the agency or person conducting the home study or home study update and remove the requirement that the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation and the Department of Human Services forward information to conduct a home study investigations. The measure also changed language regarding age for household resident subject to a name-based search from over the age of eighteen to eighteen years of age or older and changed United States Immigration and Naturalization Service to United States Citizenship and Immigration Services as it relates to fingerprint-based criminal background searches.
