Engrossed SB 368 modifies the Oklahoma Religious Freedom Act to prohibit any governmental entity from declaring or deeming a religious institution and any activity directly related to the institution's discharge of its mission and purpose to be nonessential and they shall not be subject to closure or restriction greater than that imposed on any private entity facing similar conditions.
