**Research Analysis**

SB 38 places oversight of the drug court programs established by the Oklahoma Drug Court Act with the Administrative Office of the Courts. The measure extends judicial immunity to any duty required by law to be performed by a judge of a drug court. The measure also establishes a county Drug Court Fund under the county treasurer's management. All monies received by the county drug court shall accrue to the Drug Court Fund.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The measure provides that all funds received by a drug court, in its capacity as a drug court, shall be credited to and accounted for in the county treasurer's office.

Upon review and with consultation from the Administrative Office of the Courts, no direct impact to state revenues or expenditures is anticipated from passage of the measure.
