Research Analysis

SB 385 authorizes retail spirits and wine licensees to host alcoholic beverage tastings, so long as certain provisions are met, including:

Samples are restricted to persons 21 years and older;

Samples are limited to 1 fluid ounce of spirits, 2 fluid ounces of wine and 3 fluid ounces of beer per consumer per day;

Samples must be consumed on the licensed premises;

Samples must be poured from original sealed packaging; and

No more than six bottles of alcoholic beverages are unsealed at any given time.

No alcoholic beverages unsealed in connection with sampling are permitted to remain on the licensed premises at the end of the business day.
