**Research Analysis**

Engrossed SB428 requires the director of OMES to initiate a request for proposal to determine which state applications and databases can be transferred immediately to a cloud-based data storage platform. The applications and databases eligible to be transferred would be limited to customer relationship management tools, case management tools, workflow tools and supplemental financial systems. OMES would be authorized to enter into a contract for these cloud-based data services.
