Research Analysis

SB 460 requires industrial hemp licensees to report certain changes to the United States Department of Agriculture Farm Service Agency, in addition to the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry (ODAFF).

The measure also allows industrial hemp processor licensees to remediate legally grown hemp so long as all THC is removed and it is processed as cannabidiol (CBD).

Lastly, the measure clarifies that ODAFF must have licensees present at the time of inspection and sampling.
