Research Analysis

The floor substitute to SB 47 prohibits uncontracted third-party food delivery platform from offering pick-up or delivery services from a restaurant without obtaining an agreement with the restaurant. The measure provides that a violations are subject to a fine of \$250 and an additional \$250 for each day of noncompliance. The measure also allows a person to bring civil suit against violators.

Fiscal Analysis

The first floor amendment to the measure is a floor substitute. The amendment would require platforms that offer third-party delivery services for restaurants to obtain an agreement with specific restaurants before offering delivery services for that restaurant. The measure provides fines for platforms that violate the provisions of the measure.

Upon review, passage of the measure may have a positive revenue impact to the state. The fine described in the measure does not currently exist, and so creating it may generate revenue for the state. The exact amount would depend on the number and disposition of cases.
