**Minimal Impact**

**Research Analysis**

SB 49 increases the application fee for an original chiropractic license from \$175 to \$300 and removes the examination fee of \$175. The measure also lowers the fee for an original license by relocation of practice from \$350 to \$300. Lastly, the measure broadens the entities who may administer examination to practice chiropractic in the state by adding the National Board of Chiropractic Examiners to the list of entities.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The measure increases the non-refundable application fee from \$175.00 to \$300.00 while eliminating the \$175.00 examination fee. The fee for applications for an original license by relocation of practice is reduced from \$350.00 to \$300.00.

The Board indicates the revenue impact may approach \$5,000, however most agency revenue results from license renewal fees and the impact will have minimal effect. FY-20 revenue to the agency totaled \$286,290.
