Research Analysis

SB54 creates the "Purple Star Campus" designation for public school districts, and requires the State Department of Education to give this designation to schools that qualify.

To qualify, a school district or individual school shall:

- Designate a school employee to identify military-connected students and serve as the point of contact at the school for such students and their families;
- Maintain a webpage on the campus website that includes resources for militaryconnected students and their families;
- Maintain a transition program that assists military-connected students who are new to the school;
- Offer professional development for school employees on issues related to militaryconnected students.

The measure defines "military-connected student" as a student who is a dependent of a current or former member of:

- 1. The United States military;
- 2. The Oklahoma National Guard; or
- 3. A reserve force of the United States military.

Fiscal Analysis

To implement and administer the program, SDE anticipates that the school district will submit an application to SDE for designation as a purple star campus. SDE staff will review and evaluate the application and make a determination if the school district meets the criteria and qualifies for the designation. SDE believes that it will need a .5 FTE at a program specialist grade to administer the program.

The school districts may also incur cost to meet the requirements stated in the bill including among other things maintaining a website, maintaining a transition program and offering professional development.

Projected personnel cost for SDE (.5 FTE salary plus benefits) - \$41,000
