Research Analysis

The floor substitute to SB 574 modifies and adds new definitions to the measure. The floor substitute requires the Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA) to establish a health information exchange certification with input from stakeholders. Such certification is required for a health information exchange organization to qualify as an Oklahoma Statewide Health Information Exchange (OKHIE). Until certification is established by OHCA, an OKHIE shall mean either OKSHINE or a health information exchange organization that was previously certified by the Oklahoma Health Information Exchange Trust.

KEY DIFFERENCES BETWEEN FLOOR VERSION AND FLOOR SUBSTITUTE:

The floor substitute adds a new subsection B in Section 1 of the measure and deletes what was subsection C in Section 1 of the engrossed floor version.
