**Research Analysis**

Amendment 1 to SB 605 removes language from the exception in the bill for a licensed pharmacist or pharmacy to not be criminally or civilly liable solely for dispensing an opioid drug if “the licensed pharmacist or pharmacy responsible for dispensing the drug pursuant to a prescription confirms verbally with the prescriber or the prescriber’s representative that a patient notification as provided by subparagraph b of paragraph 1 of this subsection has been received and the pharmacist notes this in the record for the prescription.”
