SB 61 specifies the location of various highway intersections designated as high-wide corridors. The measure also removes the high-wide corridor designation from the intersection of US-177 and US-64, proceeding east on US-64 to SH-108 as well as the intersection of US-64 and SH108, proceeding south on SH-108 and ending at SH-51.
