Research Analysis

The engrossed version of SB626 allows a student's parent or guardian to disclose to their child's school district if the student has received inpatient or emergency outpatient mental health services from a mental health facility in the previous 24 months. If such information is disclosed to a school district, a designated school employee, the parent, and representatives from the mental health facility shall meet to determine whether the student needs certain accommodations, including an IEP.
