Research Analysis

The committee substitute for SB639 prohibits students from receiving an OHLAP scholarship after a cumulative time period of 6 years, beginning with students who enter the program in the 2021-2022 school year.

The measure also requires the Executive Director of the Commerce Department, in consultation with the State Regents, to annually publish a list of critical occupation areas in the state. The Regents and the Career Tech State Board will identify CareerTech programs that correlate to these critical occupation areas. The OHLAP scholarship will extend to students completing programs in these critical occupation areas.
