Research Analysis

SB 677 removes the requirement for the court clerk to first offer all or part of the records subject to destruction to the Archives and Records Division of the Oklahoma Department of Libraries for preservation. The measure also authorizes destruction of court records related to a domestic relations case in which a minor child is involved after 20 years, and records related to a domestic relations case that does not involve a minor child after 10 years. Records pertaining to protective orders may be destroyed 1 year after the case was dismissed and no further action taken in the case, or 10 years after the order was issued.
