Research Analysis

SB 684 allows the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs, the Oklahoma Highway Patrol and the Oklahoma Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission to enter into interagency transfers among commissioned law enforcement officers. No transfer can be for a period of two years or less and the temporary assignment period shall not exceed five years in length.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure authorizes the State Bureau of Investigation, the Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs, the Highway Patrol, and the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission to enter into interagency agreements for the temporary transfer of commissioned law enforcement officers among the agencies. Such agreements shall be bilateral.

Upon review, no direct impact to state revenues or expenditures is anticipated from passage of the measure. The measure contains permissive language. House staff expects any costs associated with the transfer of officers to be addressed in memoranda of understanding between agencies and such transfers to occur within existing budget resources of agencies.
