**Research Analysis**

SB 69 provides that a student shall be eligible to enroll in a statewide virtual charter school if his or her parent is transferred, or is pending, transfer, to a military installation within the state while on active military duty. The measure requires virtual charter schools to accept electronic applications. Lastly, the measure defines the process for providing proof of residence.
