**Research Analysis**

FA2 for SB714 provides that the absentee voting board must deliver ballots and materials to incapacitated voters in nursing homes or veterans facilities who requested them any day following the request deadline. FA2 also authorizes that a voter who becomes physically incapacitated after the absentee ballot request deadline may make a written absentee ballot request. An individual deployed as a first responder or emergency worker after the request deadline may also make a written absentee ballot request.
