Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to SB 715 creates the Hometown Auto-Jobs Act of 2022. The measure requires a factory or third party acting on behalf of a factory to follow certain requirements relating to the protection of consumer data. The measure clarifies that the definition of "new motor vehicle dealer" does not include "powersports vehicle dealer". The measure provides definitions for "consumer data", "data management system" and "fleet vehicle" as used in the act. The measure provides that a factory or an entity affiliated by any ownership or control by the factory shall not be permitted to be licensed as a new motor vehicle dealer except under certain circumstances. The measure clarifies the ability of the Oklahoma Motor Vehicle Commission to impose a fine for violations and clarifies possible violations. The measure allows for a designated successor to a departing dealership operator. The measure clarifies "relevant market area" of a proposed new motor vehicle dealership. The measure provides a definition of "motor vehicle liability policy".
