**Research Analysis**

SB 718 clarifies the name of this act to be the Oklahoma Allopathic Medical and Surgical Licensure and Supervision Act. The measure specifies that the practice of medicine and surgery as defined by this act does not include any person who is licensed to practice medicine and surgery in another state or territory of the U.S. who engages in consultation through telehealth with a patient physically located in Oklahoma for the sole purpose of providing an expert second opinion.
