**Research Analysis**

SB 747 prohibits any insurer from unfairly discriminating against an insured or applicant for insurance based solely on the vaccination or immunity status of the insured. The measure specifies the discriminatory acts which are prohibited.

The measure declares an emergency.

**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 747 says that insurance companies cannot discriminate against people based on their vaccination or immunity status. According to officials at the Oklahoma Insurance Department, this measure does not create a fiscal impact for OID.
