Engrossed SB748 privileges the reports, statements, memoranda, proceedings, findings and other records submitted to or generated by a design professional peer reviewer or review committee. These would be exempt from discovery, subpoena or other means or legal compulsion for release, and would be inadmissible as evidence in a judicial or administrative proceeding.
