# **Fiscal Analysis**

The first floor amendment to the measure is a page-line amendment. The amendment would restore stricken language in the floor version of the bill that would have eliminated the authority of the Oklahoma Tax Commission to audit alcoholic beverage license holders for tax compliance. The amendment would keep stricken language referencing specific thresholds for compliance for categories of alcoholic beverages.

Upon review and with consultation from the OTC, the first floor amendment modifies the fiscal impact of the measure. By restoring the authority of the tax commission to audit alcoholic beverage license holders, the amendment would no longer cause a significant decrease in state revenues. The OTC estimates an unknown, but minimal impact to state revenues.
