**Research Analysis**

Engrossed SB758 authorizes the Real Estate Appraiser Board to employ a director to oversee the organization and activities of the board, and ensure compliance with rules promulgated by the board. Employees of the board would be hired by and subject to supervision of the director, and would be considered unclassified employees of the Insurance Department for the purpose of administrative support provided by the Insurance Department.
