**Research Analysis**

SB 760 allows mixed beverage, beer and wine, bottle club, caterer, charitable event, public event or special event licensees who operate in a facility with multiple licensed premises within the facility to allow persons to transport alcoholic beverages within the entire premises, which shall be designated as a common drinking area. The property owner and all licensees within the facility who desire the entire premises to be designated as a common drinking area must notify the ABLE Commission in writing.
