SB775 authorizes the Department of Agriculture to create and maintain the Livestock Offender Registry which shall contain a list of all persons convicted of stealing livestock. The public will have access to the registry.

The measure requires the county in which the offender is convicted to submit a copy of the judgement and sentence confirming the conviction to the Department of Agriculture.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 775 creates the Livestock Offender Registry. Officials at the Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry say as the bill is currently written there is no fiscal impact for the agency as they can work with another organization to administer the registry. If the Department has to administer the directory itself, then there would be a fiscal impact to the Department. Therefore, as the bill is currently written creates no fiscal impact for the Department, there is no fiscal impact to the State.
