Research Analysis

SB 782 directs any pharmacy maintaining drugs in an emergency medication kit to establish a policy and procedures governing the maintenance and dispensation of such drugs. The measure also authorizes pharmacies to designate a person who will be responsible for transmitting required information for dispensation of controlled dangerous substances to the central repository of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control. Pharmacies are required to register the emergency medication kit as a pharmacy location with the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control and comply with the requirements for controlled dangerous substances. The total volume of each controlled dangerous substance in each kit is limited to three doses per licensed bed or sixty individual doses.
