**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for SB784 authorizes the Attorney General's Office of Civil Rights Enforcement to receive and investigate complaints of discrimination at a public school or state university.

The AG's office is authorized to initiate periodic compliance reviews to assess the practices of public schools or state colleges to determine whether they comply with the laws and regulations enforced by the office. The Office shall have broad discretion to determine the substantive issues for review and the number and frequency of the reviews. The Office may also conduct directed investigations.

Lastly, the measure creates the Oklahoma Education Commission to research how to improve the quality of instruction through distance and remote modalities. The commission will consist of 15 members and last through 2027.
