**Research Analysis**

SB 811 requires all law enforcement agencies in Oklahoma to have 25% of all employed CLEET certified full-time peace officers to be trained in crisis intervention training by November 1, 2024. The measure directs CLEET to provide in the 8 hour continuing law enforcement training a mandatory 1 hour on crisis de-escalation training. The measure also directs CLEET to provide a minimum of 4 hours of education and training in crisis de-escalation training in the basic academy.
