**Research Analysis**

The floor amendment to SB 821 adds to the definition of pharmacy benefits management to exclude the activities of an employer or union that, operates a pharmacy or directly contracts with a pharmacy. It also excludes activities of a third party in assisting an employer or union with the administration or claims, billing, or payment processing.

The floor amendment removes language in the measure that prohibits a health insurer or pharmacy benefits manager from requiring or incentivizing individuals by certain means.
