**Research Analysis**

Engrossed SB 828 removes a requirement that no deputy of a principal county officer may receive a salary in excess of the principal officer. The measure also authorizes a county to utilize the appropriate State of Oklahoma pay structure in lieu of the salary code specified in statute.

**Fiscal Analysis**
