**Research Analysis**

The House Committee Substitute for SB858 empowers a board of county commissioners to expend federal funds made available to the county through the CARES Act or similar relief funds, according to the permissible uses of the legislation or guidance issued by a federal agency, regardless of any lack of specific state statutory authorization to perform the duties or functions for which the federal government has provided the funds. Receipt by the county of CARES Act or similar relief funds will not be considered a supplemental appropriation, and will not be considered revenue when setting the county's budget for the next fiscal year.

**Fiscal Analysis**
