**Research Analysis**

Engrossed SB866 clarifies the authority of certain state agencies to develop, issue, and award solicitations associated with facility plans or project plans approved by a licensed architect or engineer who is a full-time employee of the agency. Requirements of the Public Facilities Act and the Public Competitive Bidding Act must still be met by the agency.

The measure also clarifies that this authority granted to the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department applies only to projects in excess of \$50,000.
