Research Analysis

SB 970 modifies the definition of "record" within the Oklahoma Open Records Act to exclude any portion of a document or information provided to a state agency or entity to obtain licensure that contains an applicant's personal address, phone number, electronic mail address or other contact information. The measure authorizes public bodies keeping such information to release the records at their discretion, provided, identifying information relating to the occupants of any residential structure and email addresses shall be redacted in addition to other personal identifiers required to be redacted by current law.
