## **Research Analysis**

SB 979 authorizes domestic, foreign, and alien insurance companies owned or financially controlled in whole or in part by another state of the United States, a foreign government or any political subdivision thereof to only apply for a certificate of authority as a reinsurer. Such entities must establish and maintain a regional home office in the state as well as maintain a security deposit with a bank located in the state.
